Westinghouse Granted Two-Year Exception Relief for Selling T8 700 Series Fluorescent Lamps

Philadelphia, PA (October 2012) – The US Department of Energy Hearing and Appeals has granted Westinghouse Lighting a two-year exception relief from the new DOE efficiency standards that went into effect for certain general service fluorescent lamps on July 14, 2012.

As a result of this decision, Westinghouse Lighting will continue to sell 700 series T8 lamps and the products will remain in the Westinghouse product line for two additional years.
